


ewelease farm

getting there....

By Car: Google Maps 'Ewelease Farm Osmington' brings you to the farm entrance. (The postcode will only get you close by). If in doubt we are south/seaward of the main road.

<p>From the West (Weymouth) proceed through Preston and up the hill to Osmington. At the 30 sign for Osmington turn right onto a farm track. Drive for 1km over the hill and down to the farm.</p>		<p>From the East (A35) take the B3390 and A353 to Osmington. Drive through the village and on exiting turn left at the 40 sign onto a farm track. Drive for 1km over the hill and down to the farm.</p>

By train to Weymouth

- National Rail to Weymouth, from Bournemouth/Southampton/Waterloo, Bristol/Bath and other locations. Take a taxi or bus from Weymouth

By coach to Weymouth

- National Express to Weymouth, from Bournemouth and other locations
- X51 / X53 Jurassic Coaster bus from Dorchester / Bridport / Axminster to Weymouth then local bus from Weymouth
- X52 Jurassic Coaster bus from Poole to Weymouth. Get off in Osmington (see On Foot directions below).
- X54 Jurassic Coaster bus from Wareham / Lulworth / Hamworthy / Poole. Get off in Osmington (see On Foot directions below).

By local bus from Weymouth

- 503 Weymouth to Bowleaze Cove, walk from there
- X52 Weymouth to Osmington, walk from there

By taxi from Weymouth

- 01305 777777 - 01305 777333 - 01305 707070 - 01305 775151 - 01305 782222
- Ask – some drivers will drop you right down by reception, others 800m away on the track

On foot

- From Weymouth, east along the coast path until you find the site (3 miles)
- From Bowleaze, east along the coast path until you find the site (½ mile)
- From The Spice Ship, Preston, along Church Lane to the end, pick up the footpath heading south and when you get into a large field head left/east until you get to the site (¾ mile)
- From Osmington, west along the main road to the footpath signposted next to North Hill Manor, follow the footpath to the site (½ mile)
